The Gateway Equity Target sets out that 25% of commencing domestic undergraduates will be from low SES backgrounds or Gateway schools by 2027.

Our primary strategy for reaching this target is the Gateway Admission Pathway.



The Gateway Admission Pathway is an alternative pathway to UNSW which offers early entry to UNSW.

Early Offer – Round 1 only Finish HSC and receive an ATAR Early Conditional Offer -Round 1 and Round 2 Adjusted ATAR

Attend a Gateway School





Live in a low-SES area

Case study

- 1. Visit Interactive map
 - View: Statistical Area Level 1 (SA1) 2021
 - Increase transparency
- 2. Input student's address
 - 17 Barton Road Artarmon
- 3. Check IRSAD and IEO index's
- 4. If SEIFA percentile is ≤25 then the student lives in a low-SES area





If your student is eligible:

Early offer

- No ATAR requirement
- Must sit HSC and receive an ATAR
- Round 1 only
- DATE

Early conditional offer

- Adjusted ATAR requirement
- Round 1 and 2
- DATE
 - UNSW Gateway 2024 Adjusted ATARs




Application requirements
