The Program

- Study a Bachelor of Education (Secondary) or Master of Teaching (Secondary) full-time with UNSW locally in the Riverina
- Work part-time and get paid a salary as a paraprofessional secondary school teacher in a Riverina school (\$66,000 p.a. full-time pro rata before tax in 2023)
- Receive a training allowance (\$7,500 p.a. in 2023)
- Wrap around support from the Department of Education, UNSW Riverina Teaching Hub and mentoring from a supervising teacher
- Offer of a permanent position in a NSW Government School within the Riverina upon completion of degree
